Responsibilities:

- Abide by Community Covenant during all EYC events, meetings, and trips.
- Attend Diocesan Safe Church Training. (One time requirement. Date TBA)
- Attend Advisor Training and Planning Sessions (Initially mid to late August then 2-3 times throughout the year).
- Periodically attend EYC Design Team Meetings and guide teens with planning.
- Be an adult friend.
- Be here.
- Provide feedback and assistance to youth director.
- Regularly attend parish worship services and/or adult formation classes as part of your spiritual growth.
- Attend milestones associated with your class and when possible other youth recognition events (i.e. Litany of Welcome, Rite-13 Celebration, Rite-16 Driver's License Celebration, Rite-13 Liturgy of Civic Responsibility, Graduating Senior Celebration Dinner, Urban Adventure, Pilgrimage, etc.)
- Assist in leading EYC meetings (games, devotionals, etc) and regularly engage with you small group.
- Complete Volunteer Application & Background Consent Form.

Time Commitment:

- One program year (July-July).
- 3 Sunday nights per week for EYC meeting and dinner.
- 3 hours 3 times per school year for Advisor Chill-n-Grills (team dinner, fellowship, planning and continuing education held Sept – May).
- 3-4 events/trips per year (Lock-in, Beach Trip, Fall Retreat, Stream Clean, Diocesan Youth Event, etc.).
